



Tri-County Electric Cooperative (TCEC), located in the Panhandle of Oklahoma, requests Statements of Qualifications and fixed hourly price Bids for **Monitoring and Inspection** of line contractors permanent repair work related to an April 2017 **Snow Storm (FEMA/OEM DR4315 PW91)** in Texas county, Oklahoma. Line Contractors construction work consists of re-spanning, replacement of conductor, removing and relocating poles and cross-arms and installation of additional poles and cross-arms on 855.9 miles of single-phase and 463.7 miles of three-phase lines.

Monitoring and Inspection Contractor work will include monitoring construction, redlining staking sheets, and final inspection of line contractors work consistent with staking sheets, construction standards and good utility practices. Contractor shall provide and TCEC shall assign one individual monitor/inspector for approximately 5 to 6 construction crews. Contractor shall provide alternate monitors and ensure all assigned crews are monitored at least once daily. Permanent repair work is expected to begin in the first quarter of 2019 and extend continuously over multiple years.

- Prospective contractor for monitoring and final inspection shall be familiar with NISC MapWise and will also be responsible for coordinating with NISC and TCEC to set up VPN access and NISC user account. Contractor will be responsible for providing computers and their own IT support.
- Contractor shall become familiar with staking sheets and materials generated with NISC MapWise.
- Contractor shall become familiar with TCEC construction units.
- Bids shall be an hourly rate. A not to exceed amount will be determined at the time of execution of Contract. Quantities shown are approximate. Total miles could be reduced or increased with no change to hourly cost bids.
- Hourly costs shall include all travel, lodging, meals, fuel, equipment and any miscellaneous costs associated with meetings, review or other items.
- DART rate and OSHA 300 log shall be submitted with bid package.
- A copy of Commercial General Liability Insurance Policy shall be submitted with bid package. Accord certificate is not acceptable.
- **Bidders awarded work** will be required to submit a copy of Commercial General Liability Insurance Policy **with TCEC as additional insured before work begins. Accord certificate is not acceptable.**
- **Bidders awarded work will be required to have or obtain;** liability insurance covering operations of not less than \$2 million each occurrence, property damage not less than \$2 million each occurrence, and \$2 million aggregate for accidents; liability auto insurance covering \$2 million per person, \$2 million each occurrence, and \$2 million property damage each occurrence.

TCEC invites qualified consultants to submit a Bid package based upon the services outlined above. TCEC promotes equal opportunity and encourages all contractors including minority-owned, women owned, and small business enterprises to bid.



To receive consideration, bid packages must be developed and submitted within these parameters:

Formal bid opening will be held on November 20, 2018, 1:00 PM CDT.

Selection Criteria Include:

1. Written description of project understanding, workflow and procedures for monitoring and inspection.
2. The specialized experience and technical competence of the firm with respect to personnel whom will be in the field monitoring and inspecting line contractors work;
3. Monitors and Inspectors availability over potentially continuous multiple years to monitor and inspect all projects.
4. The past record of performances of the firm, safety record, and the ability of the firm to stay up with Line Contractors and ability to complete inspection by 7 days after construction is complete.
5. Fixed Hourly Price.

TCEC reserves the right to reject any, and all proposals and to select one firm or multiple firms and award a contract that is deemed to be in the best interest of the utility.
